Kitsune 16

Belizean cacao rum, Cognac, matcha
strawberry, wasabi, milk-clarified

SERVED ON CUBE

Kitsune are shapeshifters. Wildly intelligent, long-living, and powerful, they are most often recognized in their natural shape: a multi-tailed fox

Kappa 17

Cucumber vodka, Empirical Soka, vanilla acid blend, sparkling sake

SERVED ON CUBE

These aquatic creatures are fond of cucumbers and politeness. Disrespect these celebrated Yōkai, and they'll change their snack of choice.



Tanuki 18

Kumquat, Imo Shochu, Blanco Tequila
Champagne syrup, malic acid

SERVED ON FROZEN GRAPES AND ICE SPHERE

Rambunctuous, jovial, and magical. Tanuki Yōkai are often seen with a bottle of Shochu in hand, encouraging passerby to engage in debauchery.



Jinmenju 16

Mezcal, mandarin, coconut, salted honey
Sherry blend, tonic water

SERVED ON PEBBLE ICE

Jinmenju resemble fruit, dangling from tree branches. They love to smile and joke around but make them laugh too hard, and they'll fall to their demise.

Gin, aloe, lychee, kiwi, nori dry vermouth, citrus

SERVED VERY TALL ON ICE

*A beautiful woman by day, at night, Rokurokubi
uncoil their necks and terrorize their victims*



Kirin 17

Aquavit, pineapple, chapparal amaro
maraschino, lime

SERVED UP

*Deerlike creatures with dragon scales and a
serene demeanor, Kirin are majestic allies*



Tengu 20

Citron Anejo Tequila, umeshu, alpine amaro
rooibos, citrus, yuzukosho

SERVED UP

*Aggressive and arrogant, Tengu are iconic birdlike
symbols of power and military prowess.*
